17- 1c BHJ slip down the middle (2c up) ; and up to $2 \mathrm{pl}(2,1,3)$
25- $2 \mathrm{c}+1 \mathrm{c}+3 \mathrm{c}$ (NHJ on sidelines) slip down and back

9- 1c+4c Pick up cnrs LH and continue double wheel half round ; set to cnrs, change place with cnr LH
172c+3c (middles) pick up new cnrs for $1 / 2$ RHA in double wheel ; set to cnrs and change place using sideline hand to finish in end places with $1 \mathrm{c}+4 \mathrm{c}$ in the
 middle NHJ facing ends
25- $1 \mathrm{c}+4 \mathrm{c}$ dance through ends, cast to middle ; $1 / 2 \mathrm{R} \& \mathrm{~L}(2,4,1,3)$

9-16 1s dance Pass+Turn with 1st corners \& pass RSh to face 2nd corners, dance Pass+Turn with 2nd corners \& end BtoB facing 3rd corners
17-24 1s dance $1 / 2$ Diag reel of 4 with 3rd corners, pass RSh \& dance $1 / 2$ reel with 4th corners \& end 2nd place opposite sides
25-32 $3 s+1 s+2 s$ dance Set+Link for 3 twice

17- DTr up / down, finish 2pl own side (3x,1,2x)
25- diagonal R\&L (M down, W up) $(2,1,3)$

25-32 $2 s+1 s$ dance $3 / 4$ R\&L \& circle left $1 / 2$ way

29-32 All tum right hands $11 / 2$ times to own side.

 NH making arch above 1W), all three dance up in TRIUMPH to finish 2M in own place and 1c BHJ on opposite sides

1c Poussette down the middle to bottom $\mathrm{pl}(1 / 4 \mathrm{R}$ turn, progress, $1 / 4$ turn, $1 / 4$ turn, progress, progress with $1 / 4$ turn, $1 / 2$ turn to own side, fall back to sides), (all other couples step up on 23-24).
